

Critical Resistance: Honoring the Life & Legacy of Masai Ehehosi



”With heavy hearts, we’re writing to honor the sudden loss and long legacy of our beloved co-founder and longtime member Masai Ehehosi. Masai passed away peacefully in his sleep on April 1, 2024. A former political prisoner targeted for his revolutionary activity with the Black Liberation Army (BLA), at the time of his passing Masai was Critical Resistance’s (CR) longest-standing member. Masai worked for the liberation of his people for over 50 years, and held a profound presence in the multiple organizations he was in. A **co-defendant of Safiyah Bukhari** captured by police in 1973 as a BLA member, Masai began working with the [American Friends Services Committee \(AFSC\)](#) and was staff of the **AFSC’s Criminal Justice Program** in Newark, NJ after being released from 14 years of prison in Virginia. At AFSC, Masai worked to close security housing units and end torture against imprisoned people through AFSC’s **Prison Watch Program**. At the time of his passing, Masai was also the current Co-Minister of Information for the Provisional Government of the Republic of New Afrika, an advisory

board member of [The Jericho Movement](#) working on the **Jericho Medical Project** for both state and federal prisoners, and was supporting the **Prison and Gang Program of Al-Ummah and the Imam Jamil (Al-Amin) Action Network**. It is hard to put into words what Masai meant to CR and the movement to abolish the prison industrial complex (PIC), because in a way Masai was everything—representing so much of where CR comes from and sustains. A pillar of CR, it was Masai’s experience and expertise that helped CR as an organization generate a [revolutionary purpose and vision](#). Masai’s involvement with CR began on the steering committee for [our second conference, CR East: Beyond the Prison Industrial Complex](#). After helping to start CR as a national organization two months later, Masai remained an active national CR member from 2001-2024.



For over two decades he was a consistent presence: struggling with his comrades; showing us how to make connections and build power across communities, across sectors, across geographies, and movements; representing the New Afrikan Independence Movement; and teaching us the utmost importance of political unity to our struggle. From his start with CR until his final days, Masai relentlessly and persistently maintained a commitment and accountability to Black liberation, sovereignty, self-determination, land and

nationalist struggles here and globally, and an unwavering focus on solidarity with political prisoners, or, as Masai reminded us and insisted, “prisoners of war.”

Masai will be remembered for so much in CR—his kindness and warmth, full and pure heart, deep and abundant generosity, loyalty, sweet and affectionate smile, tenacious discipline, and more. Over the years, Masai helped to grow, strengthen and inform CR’s membership and methods across generations, teaching younger organizers the PIC’s design as well as the purposes of counter-insurgency and political repression. In addition to organizing CR’s conferences, Masai helped build CR through our previous National Organizing Body and National Political Education and Membership workgroups. A repeat contributor to our newspaper *The Abolitionist* from [its second issue in 2005](#) to its [fortieth issue most recently on control units](#), it was Masai who suggested doing an issue on control units and abolitionist struggle. Soft spoken and humble, yet persistent—and never one to make a fuss—Masai had a way of breaking down complex systems, histories, and strategies in straight-forward, grounded ways, while still holding nuance and profound depth.

Always describing himself **first as a Muslim**, Masai lived up to his name and was a true, devoted warrior for liberation and revolutionary change. Remembered dearly by his five children, three grandchildren, two siblings, a plethora of nieces and nephews, countless comrades, and each of his organizations, we know Masai’s teachings, guidance, sacrifice, and commitment will live on in us. We will continue to stay the course Masai and others set us on years ago—**dismantling**, in Masai’s words “*the whole complex*” of capture, control and caging, **changing our conditions**, and **building an international movement for PIC abolition**.

CR is processing this big loss, and will continue to reflect on Masai’s contributions to our organization and the broader struggle. CR is in discussion with Masai’s daughters about **hosting a movement memorial in honor of Masai** to rejoice in his memory and uplift his legacy. National Jericho’s Tribute to Masai

In Memory of

Comrade Brother Masai Ehehosi

What does the passing of our Comrade Brother Masai Ehehosi mean to the people and the Movements he represented?



As a close Muslim brother and comrade to Masai, I, along with Brother Waziri Mustafaa Waliuddin (Chair of Atlanta Jericho) and Bilal Stroud (Asst. Mgr. of Janaza Services of Georgia), had the distinct honor and privilege to wash and shroud his body, and to place and situate him in the ground at the burial site. Although I have heard about him for decades, as all of us Black Liberation Army members have heard about each other before one day actually meeting, I met Comrade Masai after I got out of prison and off federal parole. It had to be anytime around 2006 or shortly afterwards. It was at one of those zillion political programs or conferences. And there he was, chilling calmly against a wall. I introduced myself and within seconds we were rapping like we grew up together. Within minutes we analyzed the political state of affairs and figured out what had to be done. And, no, we didn’t go back out to our cars and strap up (LOL), but we did realize that somehow, as Black Panthers and BLA members we had to be very intentional, focused, and strategic about passing on our torch... the torch of

courageous, disciplined, staunch resistance against oppression and injustice and standing firm and resolute in building self-determination and self-reliance amongst our people. That was Comrade Masai, before I met him, while I knew him, and at his passing! I don’t know how effective we have been over the decade and a half since our meeting, but I am still here with the few remaining Panthers and Black Liberation Army members to do our part. We washed him, performed the ritual wudu (ablution) and ghusl (rinsing his entire body). We patted him dry and performed and shrouded him in three white sheets. This is the journey we all must take. What are we leaving behind and who is there to carry on the torch? I want Masai to know that we are still here continuing the work. But I am sure that what Masai would want us to know is that as for the struggle – win, lose, or draw – we are all returning to Allah and we all will have to make an account of ourselves as individuals. *Innallahi wa innallayhi raji’un* (From Allah we came and to Allah we shall return). We will strive to be our best Masai, we will strive to be our best. All of us must strive to be our best. That’s the lesson. Thank you Masai.

Puerto Rico bids goodbye to fighter Norberto Cintrón Fiallo

“With a career that united him with other figures who advocated the armed struggle to achieve the independence of Puerto Rico, Cintrón Fiallo is exalted by his comrades as commander, along with murdered Filiberto Ojeda Ríos, founder of the People’s Army Boricua-Macheteros.

Born in the capital of the Dominican Republic, where his mother, intellectual Thelma Fiallo Henriquez was from, the fighter stood out as a union leader. At the same time, he remained active in political organizations, such as the Pro-Independence Movement (MPI) and the clandestine Armed Liberation Commands (CAL), which Juan Mari Brás was said to have led under the pseudonym Alfonso Beal.

In the 1970s, faced with the intensification of repression in Puerto Rico against the left, he was among the organizers of the Unitary Committee Against Repression (Cucre). Cintrón Fiallo also served prison for refusing to testify before a federal grand jury, with which the United States authorities intended to break his will and that of other fighters to provide details of an armed attack against a bus occupied by members of the USA Navy.

In April 2006, agents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) broke into the apartment of his life partner, Liliana Laboy, a professor at the University of Puerto Rico, in Río Piedras, but none of this managed to reduce his impetus to fight for the independence of Puerto Rico. Since the death of Ojeda Ríos in 2005, every year Cintrón Fiallo led an event in his honor on September 23 at the Naguabo cemetery, where his remains rest.”

1. Fly into Norfolk VA. From Norfolk Allow for about 3 hours to travel for rest-stop-gas.

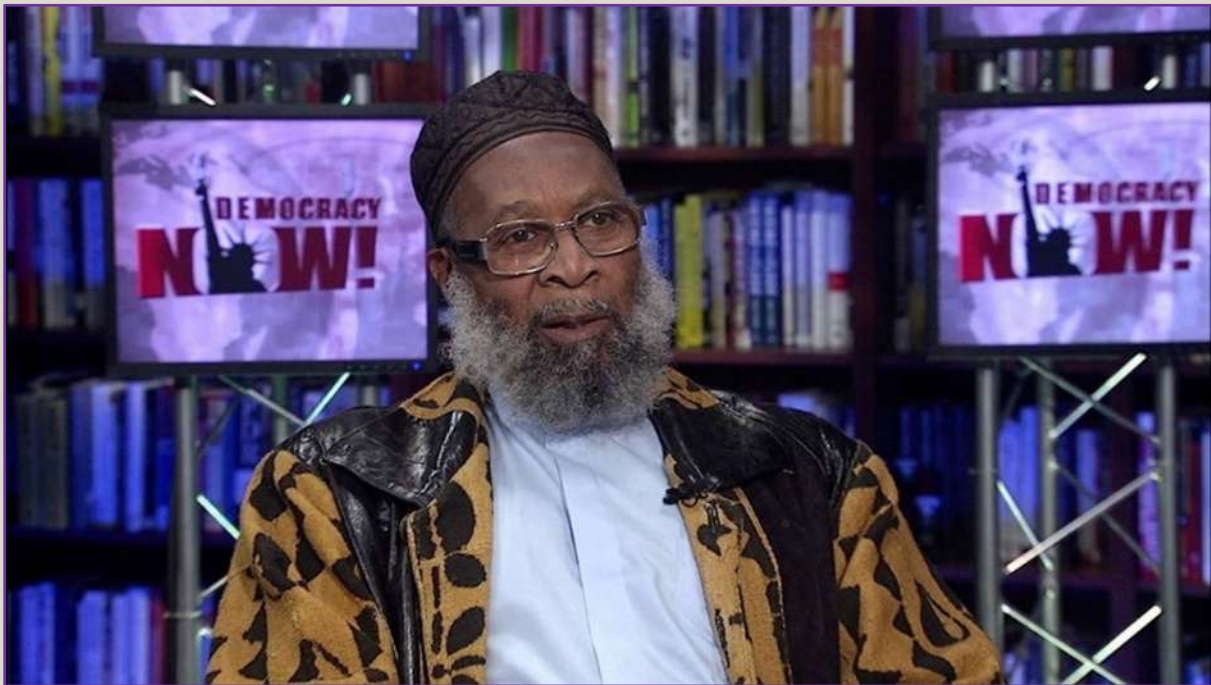
Car rentals are available at all the airports.

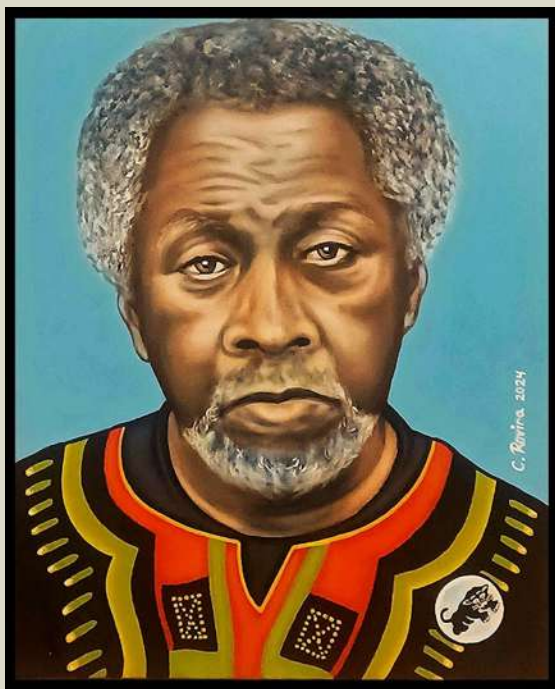
Today is Jericho Co-Founder Safiya Bukhari's Birthday April 3, 1950

**Once a Black Panther-Always a Black Panther!
Comrade Bro. James "Tarik" Haskins by Carlito Rovira**



"This is portrait I recently painted of James Haskins, better known as Tarik, an unsung hero of oppressed and exploited people. Tarik was born in Norfolk, Virginia on December 21, 1948, a region with deep historic roots in African chattel slavery. For Tarik, growing up in this scenario contributed to his understanding why Jim Crow laws and white supremacist traditions were designed to preserve Black oppression.

James Haskins is among many Black men with firsthand knowledge of horrors caused by the Vietnam War, where he served as a Marine. Tens of thousands Vietnamese civilians were killed by U.S. bombs and bayonets, while Black and Brown G.I.s also died disproportionately.

After the war Tarik became disillusioned. As a war veteran returning home, he expected changes for the better in the social and economic life, but instead he witnessed further discrimination and racist violence against Black people. This is why Tarik joined the Black Panther Party.

After COINTELPRO's destruction of the BPP, Tarik joined the Black Liberation Army (BLA). Unfortunately, by November 1974, BLA members James Haskins (Tarik), Ashante Alston, Timothy Adams, and Harold Simmons were all convicted for a failed attempt to free other BLA members held captive at The Tombs, Manhattan Detention Center. Tarik was sentenced to 17 years imprisonment.

To this day Tarik lives on without regret. He continues to uphold the noble ideals of Black emancipation by partaking in progressive causes, especially the quest to free political prisoners.

Over the years, Tarik's activism has included doing solidarity work for Palestine, Cuba, and Puerto Rico's struggle for independence. This brother has indisputably earned the noble title of Revolutionary.

1. Medical:

Bill Dunne: Bill is at Butner and has prostate cancer. The cancer cells have shrunk and he will be starting chemo.

Virgin Island Three: Shabazz has Macular degeneration, water in the back of his eye and is going in for surgery to relieve the pressure from his eye.

Leonard Peltier: Leonard is going blind and it's not clear what it is from. Will be some time until they can bring in an eye doctor. He was visited by a doctor and he said that Leonard should have a wheelchair and not a walker because of his limited abilities.

2. Legal:

Xinachtli: "Chicano anarchist political prisoner and *Certain Days* collective member Xinachtli now has new legal representation, connected to the Water Protector Legal Collective, as he prepares for an upcoming parole bid. His support crew report that: Beginning 2024, Xinachtli is scheduled for another parole review hearing, and his freedom campaign will soon announce what supporters can do to support the movement to free him from this wrongful COINTELPRO-style extra judicial captivity and 50 years jury sentence for disarming a Texas Sheriff in self defense." <https://nycabc.files.wordpress.com/2024/03/19-mar-2024.pdf>

Kevin Rashid Johnson: "Rashid has been transferred to the Eastern part of Virginia, closer to medical facilities as we all have been demanding! **Here is the new address for letters:**

He had lost a lot of weight during the hunger strike, but he has already gained back much of it. He has had his tablet restored, so he is somewhat able to communicate via email. Phone communications seem to be in the process of being restored. He is not in solitary confinement as he was at Red Onion State Prison. This report is incomplete, as communications remain somewhat spotty. **P.S. Keith LaMar (Bomani Shakur)

"Lucasville Uprising" of 1993

"In 1989, Keith LaMar (aka Bomani Shakur) was sent to prison at age 19 for murder. He had been living in Cleveland, Ohio, where he sold drugs as a means of survival in the Crack-infested streets he knew as home. On a day that would forever change his life, Keith was robbed at gunpoint and exchanged gunfire with his robbers. He was shot twice in his legs and hit one of the other men in the chest. That young man, once a childhood friend, died. Keith pled guilty and was sent to prison for 18 years-to-life.

Four years later, Keith was attempting to put together the broken pieces of his life at the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility, hoping for another chance at life. It was an Easter Sunday, and the weather had just turned warmer;

Keith and about 400 other men were outside exercising in the rec-yard when

commotion broke out inside and it became clear that some type of protest was underway. Keith made a quick decision to slip inside for a few minutes to secure his personal belongings (since his cell assignment was in the area being taken over). Once back out in the yard, he and the others waited to see what would transpire, watching as the bodies of several men were dumped onto the yard.

As Easter came to an end, the Ohio State Highway Patrol rounded up those on the yard and secured them into another part of the facility. Prison records prove that Keith was among them. Though no one could have predicted what exactly was happening, or how it would all result, an 11-day siege ensued. In the end, nine inmates and one guard ultimately lost their lives. When the dust began to settle, the State of Ohio needed someone on whom to pin several of the early inmate deaths. This is where Keith's troubles began..." For full

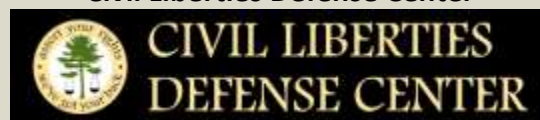

I still have not had the operation on my hip which sorely pains me constantly. I’ll be 71 in May and this prison life is more debilitating mentally and physically. May Allah bless you all for sacrifices and being wonderful human being in a world with so much uncertainties. Kojo”

We are shocked and extremely concerned that Mr Charles Leo Daniel, a man suffering serious mental illness, was found dead inside the North West Detention Centre, Tacoma, USA on 7 March 2024. Mr Daniel had been held in solitary confinement for almost four years, a form of torture. Since Mr Daniel’s death there have been two confirmed suicide attempts inside the Centre.

We are aware that, for years, detainees have been protesting inhumane conditions including [women reporting sexual assault](#) by guards, that is systematically ignored. Detainees are demanding what should be theirs as a right: edible food, a clean environment, clean clothes, a reduction of commissary prices, in person visits, etc.

La Resistencia say:

“It’s clear that the lives of people detained inside NWDC are not being protected, and that the for-profit facility is incentivised to keep people imprisoned for as long as they can. There is no right to a speedy trial inside NWDC, and Washington state citizens deserve to know that their tax dollars are being handed over to a Florida-based corporation that routinely violates human and constitutional rights.”

Our dear colleague, Maru Mora Villalpando, founder of La Resistencia has, with others, now joined detainees on hunger strike. We urge you to respond positively to detainee’s demands:

1) Shut down NWDC 2) End solitary confinement 3) An independent investigation of the death of Mr Charles Leo Daniel 4) An accountability and reparations process.

We look forward for your urgent response, and we will continue to closely monitor the situation at the NWDC.

As the death toll from Israel's war on the [Gaza Strip](#) [hit](#) at least 32,623 on Friday, the New York Working Families Party endorsed the "[Leave It Blank](#)" campaign, which encourages Democratic voters to cast a blank ballot in the state presidential primary next Tuesday to increase pressure on U.S. President Joe Biden to end the bloodshed.

Since January, when New Hampshire residents critical of U.S.

complicity in Israel's [genocidal](#) assault [wrote](#) "cease-fire" on their Democratic ballots, voters across the country have used the primary process to stage similar protests. In Michigan, home to many Muslims and Arab

Americans, over 100,000 people voted “[uncommitted](#)” last month. “Instead of disconnecting from democracy, what we need to be doing is leaning into our democracy.”

“Many New Yorkers are struggling with the question of whether to show up for Tuesday’s presidential primary. We’re urging voters to use their voice at the ballot box to send a clear message to President Biden that he must correct course on the war on Gaza,” said New York Working Families Party co-directors Ana María Archila and Jasmine Gripper in a statement.

“With the general election seven months away, voters can make a strategic appeal to President Biden to listen to the overwhelming majority of voters who support a permanent cease-fire, the safe return of hostages, and emergency humanitarian aid,” they added.

Biden is expected to face Republican former President Donald Trump in November. Although the Democratic president [called for](#) Israel to end the “indiscriminate bombing” of civilians in Gaza, his administration has also continued to arm Israeli forces—[sending](#) fighter jets and 2,000-pound bombs that can take out an entire city block. “The war in Gaza has really splintered the Democratic coalition that is urgently needed to defeat Trump and his right-wing extremist agenda,” Archila [told](#) *Gothamist*. “And it has created a very serious moral dilemma for voters across the country.”

According to *Gothamist*: Archila said she viewed the blank vote campaign as something that would engage and unify Democrats at a moment when they lack enthusiasm.

“Instead of disconnecting from democracy, what we need to be doing is leaning into our democracy,” she said.

“And we know that voters who show up in the primary are more likely to show up in a general election.”

Archila and Gripper’s party joins a growing number of groups supporting the campaign. They include IfNotNow NYC, Jewish Voice for Peace (JVP) Action, MPOWER Action: Muslim Grassroots Movement, Peace Action New York State, [Sunrise Movement](#) NYC, U.S. Campaign for Palestinian Rights Action, and multiple chapters of Democratic Socialists of America.

Members of some groups backing the “Leave It Blank” initiative were among those who [staged](#) a protest at Radio City Music Hall in New York City on Thursday as Biden was joined by former Democratic Presidents Barack Obama and Bill Clinton for a fundraiser. Jay Saper of JVP said that “we will continue to raise our voices of dissent until Palestinians are free.”

At least eight elected officials have also backed the call: state Sen. Jabari Brisport (D-25); state Reps. Zohran Mamdani (D-36), Marcela Mitaynes (D-51), and Phara Souffrant Forrest (D-57); and New York City Council Members Alexa Avilés (D-38), Tiffany Cabán (D-22), Shahana Hanif (D-39), and Sandy Nurse (D-37).

“This is our best chance to make clear that Democrats in New York will not accept the taxpayer-funded killing of innocent civilians.”

“I urge all New Yorkers who want a cease-fire to join me in casting a blank ballot in the presidential primary on April 2nd,” Hanif said in a statement Friday. “Our taxes are being used to fuel the death of Palestinians. This is a simple way we can join the national effort to encourage the president to listen to his base before it’s too late.”

The United States gives Israel \$3.8 billion in annual military aid and Biden has sought \$14.3 billion more since the Hamas-led attack on October 7, which led to Israeli forces bombing and blockading the Palestinian enclave for more than six months.

The Leave It Blank campaign “is an opportunity to register our collective outrage over the Biden administration’s continued policy of disregard for human life in the Gaza Strip,” said Avilés. “The presumptive nominee of the Democratic Party must know that its members stand with [Palestine](#).”

Noting that “Blank ballots will be counted,” Mamdani declared that “this is our best chance to make clear that Democrats in New York will not accept the taxpayer-funded killing of innocent civilians.”

In addition to New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, and Wisconsin have votes scheduled for Tuesday. *The Nation* on Friday [published](#) a guide for how to continue the “uncommitted” momentum in the remaining Democratic primaries and caucuses in U.S. states and territories.”

Google signs new deal with Israeli military during genocide- Demand Google cut ties with Israel April 16



”This morning, Time Magazine confirmed what we’ve known all along.

Google not only provides cloud computing services to the Israeli Ministry of Defense and the Israeli Occupation Forces, but the tech giant has deepened its partnership during Israel’s genocide in Gaza, signing a new agreement as recently as three weeks ago.¹ This story comes just days after two more Google workers quit the company in protest of its \$1B Project Nimbus cloud contract with Israel. Eddie Hatfield, the 23-year-old Google Cloud Engineer who was fired last month for disrupting a Google-sponsored Israeli tech conference has also just gone public for the first time since their firing. [We can’t let Google silence the courageous workers who are speaking out against their employer enabling Israel’s AI-powered genocide in Gaza. And we cannot let them continue aiding and abetting this genocide without consequence. So we’re showing up on April 16th in your area for a nationwide #NoTechForGenocide day of action. Will you join us?](#)

For almost three years, tech workers at Google and Amazon have been fighting against Project Nimbus. And today, we know that for those three years Google has been lying to its own workers, consumers, and the public in multiple statements where they stated that Project Nimbus, their \$1.2B contract with the Israeli government and military, did not have military applications.

Google is aiding and abetting an AI-powered genocide in Gaza and doing whatever it can to stop its workers from speaking out on Gaza as the No Tech For Apartheid movement grows in power and numbers.³ We have seen new reporting in recent days on the Israeli military's use of AI to power bombing and assassination efforts targeting tens of thousands of Palestinians in Gaza. And we now know, from the New York Times, that Israel is similarly using Google Photos' facial recognition tech in Gaza. It is now clearer than ever that Google's only ethical option is to withdraw fully from Project Nimbus. [That's why on April 16, workers are leading a coast-to-coast day of action to demand that Google stop doing business with Israel and providing tech to this genocide.](#)

Time's story exposes how Google's systemic retaliation. Eddie worked as a Cloud engineer on tech that allows Project Nimbus to run on sovereign Israeli servers. He raised concerns with management for months since the genocide began in October and chose to disrupt the conference from a place of deep ethical conviction that tech should be used for good, not to power genocide and apartheid.

Google had the opportunity to act on the concerns he raised, both on Project Nimbus and the harassment, discrimination, and censorship against his Muslim, Arab, and Palestinian colleagues.⁶

Instead, they fired him.

Google workers' demands for divestment are clear: Either stop powering this genocide or face a labor crisis. Our solidarity with these workers is a show of power that increases that pressure.

Around the world, Indigenous Peoples and the Earth experience challenges and violence, including access to justice and the impacts of a legal system that was not built for Indigenous Peoples and prioritizes property rights over the sacredness of the Earth. As Indigenous peoples, we are 5% world population but steward 85% of world’s biodiversity. Corporate interests, extraction and the rights of Indigenous Peoples are inextricably linked, as frontline human rights defenders (HRDs) work to defend the Earth and existence itself. In 2022, Front Line Defenders reported a grim milestone: for the first time we saw more than 400 targeted killings of human rights defenders. Latin America (known as Abya Yala in the language of the Kuna peoples), remained the deadliest region in the world for human rights defenders. The five most targeted sectors of human rights defense were: environmental, land and Indigenous Peoples’ rights (11%); freedom of expression (10%); protest movement/freedom of assembly (9%); women’s rights (7%); and impunity and access to justice (6%). 401 HRDs were killed in 26 countries in 2022 compared to 358 HRDs in 35 countries in 2021. **DID YOU KNOW that in 2021, the U.S was found GUILTY
of five accounts of genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people??**

Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict [HERE](#)), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, right-wing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
