National Jericho Support Statement
for the Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network

The National Jericho Movement expresses its support for the Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network's right to exist and its human rights obligation to build solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners and with all Political Prisoners in the United States and other countries. Every Palestinian arrested or kidnapped and incarcerated under the apartheid regime called Israel is a Political Prisoner. When a people enter a country already occupied and self-governed and usurps that land, continues to encroach upon and oppress the inhabitants, bulldozes their homes and forces them to live in increasingly smaller areas – globally now recognized as outdoor prisons – and over the 76+ years of its colonial rule has incarcerated millions, with thousands being children, every prisoner becomes a Political Prisoner because of the injustice inherent in the system itself.

Since 2011 Samidoun has made the world aware of the injustice, torture, deaths, and gross human rights violations of Palestinian Prisoners. As of October 15, 2024, the United States Treasury Department imposed sanctions on Samidoun, baselessly accusing it of acting as an international fundraiser for the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine, and thus designating it as a "specially designated terrorist" organization. Jericho also condemns the listing of Palestinian writer and organizer Khaled Barakat as part of the same attack.

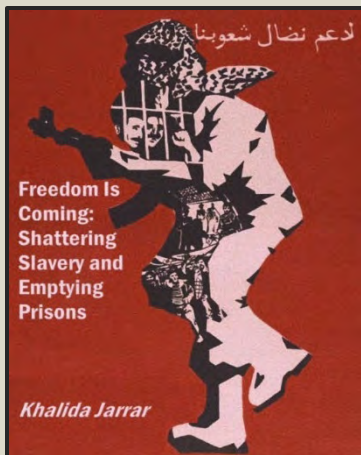
According to international law, the Palestinian people have the right to resist occupation, including through armed struggle.

Jericho will continue to support Samidoun's work in uplifting and supporting Palestinian Prisoners, as it will support all efforts to shed light on political cases, prisoners, and campaign for their freedom in the United States as well as abroad. And Jericho asks that all movement organizations that champion the rights of the oppressed do the same.

The Bronx Stands with Samidoun!



"The Bronx Anti-War Coalition stands in unwavering solidarity with the Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network and recognizes that the US and Canadian government's designation of the organization as a terrorist entity is baseless and politically motivated. By targeting Samidoun with government sanction, the US and Canadian government escalate their Zionist counterinsurgency, weaponizing terrorist designations against the Palestinian liberation movement. It aims to silence the most influential group that exposes the illegal abduction and torture of Palestinians by Israeli prisoner authorities in concentration camps. We demand the immediate removal of all sanctions against Samidoun and urge all anti-imperialist organizations to defend Samidoun and their just cause.

Samidoun, an activist organization founded in 2011, raises consciousness about Palestinian prisoners, the majority of whom Israeli Occupation Forces

kidnapped and held without charge, trial, or explanation in Zionist dungeons. Samidoun works to build solidarity with over 10,000 Palestinian prisoners, including children, suffering heinous physical, sexual, and psychological torture at the hands of Israeli soldiers. Before being abducted, imprisoned, and tortured, many Palestinians were leaders in their communities working toward the liberation of their people and land. Among them are teachers, students, doctors, nurses, organizers, and family members of resistance leaders. "Prisons" are a tool of the Zionist colonizer used to punish and retaliate against the steadfast resistance to occupation. Samidoun was one of the first organizations to offer Western audiences historical context and analysis of the Al Aqsa Flood operation. While Western mainstream media deliberately framed the October 7th operation as a senseless and unprovoked act of terrorism, leaning on Islamophobia and Anti-Arab racism to propagate this narrative, Samidoun held teach-ins to help people in Western countries like the US understand the resistance and its objectives. Through their political education and street demonstrations, people in the West understood that the Al Aqsa Flood operation was a heroic act of liberation. Palestinians in Gaza broke through the open-air prison they've been held hostage in an operation that aimed to liberate Palestinian prisoners from Zionist torture camps through prisoner exchanges. Khalida Jarrar describes it as *"the revolution of prisoners who long for their freedom and to break through the bars of their prison cells."*

Samidoun has kept the struggle to liberate Palestinian prisoners at the forefront of people's hearts and minds around the world. As their name suggests—*samidoun* meaning "steadfast people" in Arabic—this new designation will not frighten nor deter the prisoner solidarity movement from continuing this critical work. These sanctions are an effort by imperialists and Zionists to silence Samidoun and to suppress stories of Israeli torture and abuse against Palestinians from reaching the public, which they believe will curb criticism of Israel and shield it from accountability. Defending Samidoun is crucial as the US State Department rhetorically demands Israel improve humanitarian conditions in Gaza—a testament to the impact of their work. By sanctioning a major organization that reports on these horrific conditions, they attempt to engineer the *appearance* of improvement. This political persecution by reactionary governments shows their desperation as they lose the public narrative on the US/Israeli genocide against Palestinians.

The contradictions and hypocrisy of the US and Canada are stark. While labeling Samidoun as financiers of terrorism, they actively finance and arm Israeli terrorism in Palestine, Lebanon, Syria, Iran, Iraq, Yemen, and beyond. This hypocrisy is glaring when the US invites Netanyahu to address Congress, receiving standing ovations as he executes genocide, and Canada invites a literal [Nazi](#) to address its parliament.

Western liberal democracies have rendered the "terrorist" and "terrorism" labels as meaningless as "antisemite" and "antisemitism." Classifying Samidoun as a terrorist entity while supporting a state that terrorizes and massacres civilians throughout West Asia is hypocritical. It highlights the West's weaponization of "terrorism" as a racializing category meant to justify the settler state's monopoly on violence. As Ansarallah's leader, Abdul Malik al-Houthi, said, *"American classifications have no significance and only defend Israel's crimes."* People in the imperial core see through and oppose these fraudulent classifications, chanting in the streets: *"US imperialists, number one terrorists!"*

This is yet another reminder of the fascist repression against activists opposing US/Israeli genocide occurring under the Biden-Harris administration. From the Uhuru 3 and student encampments to Stop Cop City organizers and now Samidoun, designating anti-imperialists as "terrorists" demonstrates the historical refuge liberalism provides for fascism. The danger of fascism is not solely tied to any particular individual or political party, but rather it is foundational to the systems created by the settler colonies of Israel, the US, and Canada. We reiterate our solidarity with Samidoun, Khaled Barakat, and the just cause of the Palestinian people. We are proud to have collaborated with them on a teach-in on defending Palestinian resistance. We denounce all sanctions penalizing activists fighting for liberation and sovereign nations resisting US hegemony. Samidoun is a leader of Palestinian solidarity work worldwide, standing unabashedly with the heroic Palestinian prisoners and resistance. The time is now to stand in solidarity with Samidoun against these attacks by the state. Now is the time to mobilize fully in defense of Palestinian resistance." Source: Email.

Good Shepherd Collective: Support Samidoun



“As the US-Israeli genocide continues to massacre families in Gaza, destroy hospitals, bombard schools and residential buildings, and destroy life-sustaining infrastructure, the same forces are using legal methods to suppress those standing in solidarity with Palestinians abroad. Most recently, on October 15, 2024, the United States and Canada, decided to sanction Samidoun - Palestinian Prisoner Support Network, which works to educate and organize around the very central issue of Palestinian prisoners. We reject this decision and urge others to

reflect on the events that have led to it and the future it will usher in without our public and vocal resistance. This decision to target Samidoun, founded in 2011 as a dedicated support network for the more than (now) 10,000 known Palestinian prisoners languishing in Israeli occupation prisons, follows years of efforts by imperial states to dismantle the structures of Palestinian solidarity. Only last year, in November 2023, Germany also banned Samidoun — along with the slogan “from the River to the Sea, Palestine will be free.” These moves illuminate a stark reality that reflects nothing about the work of Samidoun, and everything about the desires of the decision-makers behind them: any real solidarity with Palestinians, any vision of a just future, should not be allowed in the public sphere of states like Germany, Canada, and the United States.

These attacks on Samidoun’s work are not new. Only a few years prior, in 2021, Israel itself named Samidoun a “terrorist organization” — alongside Palestinian human rights NGOs Al Haq, Addameer, Bisan Center for Research and Development, Defense for Children International - Palestine, Union of Palestinian Women’s Work Committees, and the Union for Agricultural Work Committees. This move followed a targeted pressure campaign by settler organizations in Israel, including Regavim and NGO Monitor, which identified these seven groups as some of the most influential and effective organizations supporting Palestinians in remaining on their lands.

At the time and since, Samidoun has not received the support it deserves. While the US-European network of NGOs mobilized quickly to #Standwiththe6, building the support these organizations rightly deserve, they explicitly excluded this seventh organization. This action drew a very public line that reflected who these NGOs are willing to sacrifice and whom they deem worthy of protection in the public sphere.

This is wrong. When we accept the targeted attempts at silencing, policing, and finally outlawing the work of any organization operating in solidarity with Palestinians — particularly one that represents the interests of one of the most vulnerable groups within Palestinian society — we are not only moving out of a space of real solidarity and throwing these people to the wolves. We are not only accepting the “right” of imperialists, former colonial powers, and settler colonies to demarcate what is legitimate and illegitimate in terms of advocating with and for colonized people. We are ceding ideological ground. We are inviting more attacks on the colonized people themselves, and all those who stand in solidarity with them. We are giving up more power, giving each other up, and bowing our heads to the violence of these efforts to silence us, constrict our speech and actions, and prevent the formation of real visions of justice.

This lack of support — a decision which was made and upheld over years by organizations that claim to stand in solidarity with Palestinians — is directly connected to this attack on Samidoun today.

Luckily, the folks organizing at Samidoun are steadfast (the meaning of the organization’s name in Arabic). They are unfaltering in their determination to move forward with their work. As they do so, we can correct the mistakes of the past by rejecting these heinous attacks on their work and even targeted measures against some of the individuals behind Samidoun as individuals. We can be vocal and open about our decision to support all principled solidarity with the Palestinian people. We can call for the reversal of these decisions, based on the awareness that these attacks are empty attempts to intimidate and silence, and knowing that none of us win when we sell each other out to the violence of imperial and colonial states.

During genocide, resistance cannot only look like ending the genocide. While this must be first and foremost, we must keep our eyes open and look around to see the mechanisms that allowed the genocide to begin and facilitated its continuation — for example, the US and Germany have provided almost all of the weapons Israel has used to enact genocide in Gaza. However, we must also see and resist the tightening and entrenchment of

these systems, which criminalize principled stances, target material campaigns (such as the many laws against BDS), and create new ways to harm those we care about in Palestine, and those in solidarity who also deserve to be safe and supported. We must resist these measures with all our might, for all of our sakes. “In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful

“Do not consider those who were killed in the way of Allah as dead, but rather they are alive with their Lord, receiving sustenance.”

To the Palestinian people, to the masses of our Arab and Islamic nation:

The Al-Qassam Brigades announces with pride the martyrdom of the great leader, Yahya Sinwar “Abu Ibrahim,” leader of the Islamic Resistance Movement, Hamas. He ascended to martyrdom, not retreating, in the most honorable of battles defending Al-Aqsa Mosque, our people, and their legitimate rights. It is a source of pride that our movement sacrifices its leaders before its soldiers, with leaders leading the convoy of martyrs, offering their lives and blood in the way of Allah and for the liberation of Palestine. The martyrdom of our leader, amidst his fellow fighters, as a hero engaged in battle with the invaders who thought Gaza would be an easy prey for their cowardly army, is a testament to this sacrifice.

The journey of our leader, “Abu Ibrahim,” was an honorable one, a jihadist path. He was part of the founding generation of the Islamic Resistance Movement, Hamas, and its military and security branches. He sacrificed the prime of his youth in the occupation’s prisons for more than 20 years before being freed with his head held high in the “Shalit Deal.” Upon his release, he immediately resumed the path of jihad without tasting rest. He oversaw the military operations of the movement across the three regions and played a key role in unifying the resistance fronts on the road to Jerusalem. He then led the movement in Gaza, marking a transformative period in its spiritual, political, and military journey, culminating in the “Al-Aqsa Flood” operation. His leadership extended to national relations and joint resistance efforts before he assumed leadership of the movement both inside and outside after the martyrdom of the great leader Ismail Haniyeh.

The factions of resistance, with Hamas at the core, when they decided to enter this historic and decisive battle in the jihad of the Palestinian people and the path of our nation, they knew the price of liberation is exceedingly high, a price every nation must pay before it frees itself from its occupiers. Hamas has been ready to lead the ranks of sacrifice from the heart of its people, offering leaders and soldiers alike, refusing to yield to the enemy or remain silent about its oppression and plundering of our people’s legitimate rights. Our jihad will not stop until Palestine is liberated, the last Zionist is expelled, and all our legitimate rights are restored. The clearest evidence of this is that our people have neither broken nor surrendered after a year of the “Al-Aqsa

Flood” battle, despite the heavy price they have paid and the horrific genocidal crimes committed by the Zionists.

This criminal enemy is delusional if it thinks that by assassinating resistance leaders such as Sinwar, Haniyeh, Nasrallah, Arouri, and others, it can extinguish the flame of resistance or push it to retreat. Instead, it will only intensify and escalate until our people’s legitimate goals are achieved. Martyrdom is the highest aspiration of our leaders, and their blood will be a beacon illuminating the path to liberation and a fire that will consume the aggressors. Our leaders have left behind hundreds of thousands of fighters from among our people and nation, determined to confront the Zionist occupation until Palestine and Al-Aqsa are purified of its filth, and the occupiers are expelled from our land, by Allah’s will. Indeed, it is jihad for victory or martyrdom.

France grants release to Georges Abdallah after 40 years in prison!

“Over the years, leftist MPs and human rights organizations, such as the Human Rights League (LDH) and even the French intelligence chief, have called for his release. A French court ordered on Friday the release of [Georges Abdallah](#), the Lebanese revolutionary imprisoned in France, who has been detained for 40 years. The court ruled that Abdallah, who was first arrested in 1984 and convicted in 1987, would be freed on December 6, provided that he leave France.

It is worth noting that French "anti-terrorism" prosecutors announced they would appeal the decision. "In (a) decision dated today, the court granted Georges Ibrahim Abdallah conditional release from December 6, subject to the condition that he leaves French territory and not appear there again," the prosecutors stated.

The longest-held prisoner in Europe

Abdallah, a former member of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP), has so far served 40 years in prison, which makes him the longest-held prisoner in Europe.

He founded the Marxist-Leninist Lebanese Armed Revolutionary Factions (LARF), which claimed responsibility for four attacks in France during the 1980s.

The Lebanese revolutionary was accused of taking part in the assassination of US military attache Charles Robert Ray and Israeli diplomat Yacov Barsimantov in 1982 and was sentenced on these accusations. Abdallah never responded to the list of accusations and considered that the French judicial system was "despicably" taking the resistance action out of context.

At his trial for the alleged killing of the diplomats, Abdallah was handed a life sentence—significantly harsher than the 10 years sought by prosecutors. His lawyer, Jacques Verges, called the sentence a "declaration of war." Now 73, Abdallah maintains that he is a "fighter" advocating for Palestinian rights, not a "criminal". This marks his 11th attempt at securing parole.

He became eligible for parole in 1999, but all previous applications were denied, except in 2013, when his release was conditioned on expulsion from France.

However, then-Interior Minister Manuel Valls refused to implement the order, keeping Abdallah in prison.

US interference in Abdallah's case

The United States has also consistently opposed Abdallah's release, while Lebanese authorities have repeatedly called for his freedom.

A *Wikileaks* document about former US Secretary of State Hillary Clinton's leaked emails revealed that between January 10-14, 2023, she sent an email to former French Minister of Foreign Laurent Fabius, saying that "although the French Government has no legal authority to overturn the Court of Appeal's January 10 decision, we hope French officials might find another basis to challenge the decision's legality."

Unlike previous rulings, the court's latest decision does not require government authorization, Abdallah's lawyer Jean-Louis Chalanset told *AFP*, describing the outcome as "a legal and a political victory."

Over the years, leftist MPs and human rights organizations, such as the Human Rights League (LDH) and even the French intelligence chief have been calling for his release.

Abdallah's case has garnered significant support from leftist and communist circles in France. Last month, Annie Ernaux, the 2022 Nobel Prize laureate in literature, condemned that his prolonged detention "shamed France", in an article published by the communist newspaper *L'Humanité*.

Georges Abdallah: Prisoners mirror resistance of Palestinian people

The [Lebanese revolutionary](#) sent a message on the occasion of Palestinian Prisoners' Day on April 20, affirming that celebrating this day aims above all to "confirm our duties toward the prisoners, loudly and clearly," as well as to "include their liberation in the general dynamic of our ongoing struggles."

At the time, Abdallah said that this day also aims to "encourage the lively revolutionary forces and their resisting vanguards to take all necessary measures to practically express our definite determination to liberate our comrades from the grips of their jailers."

He stressed that thousands of prisoners who have been imprisoned for many years, and some for several decades, "reflect today, more than ever, the resistance of the Palestinian people in its various forms" against the Israeli occupation.

Additionally, Abdallah emphasized that the current Israeli government, "more than any previous government, cannot but intensify repression and try to expand the destruction of everything Palestinian," especially anyone who joins the collective will of the Resistance.

He pointed out that the heroes of the revolutionary struggle, especially those who embodied the collective will of the Resistance (referring to the prisoners), are "the preferred targets of extermination policies that fascists from all spectra rush to implement, especially as the [ongoing] genocide makes it easy to do so."

In this context, [Abdallah](#) called on international movements in solidarity with the Palestinians to take this reality into account, explaining that we are "dealing with a genocide unfolding in front of everyone, not in the hidden corners of secret [detention] camps," which is being witnessed by hundreds of millions of people around the world for the first time in human history." More human remains from Philadelphia's 1985 MOVE bombing found at museum

"Be sure to watch the video of Janet, Janine and Eddie Africa: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=f-kV4v_QfU8 Additional human remains from a 1985 police bombing on the headquarters of MOVE in Philadelphia have been found at the University of Pennsylvania. These are believed to be the remains of Janet Africa's daughter Delisha. "I am hurt to the bone as my whole family is," said Janet Africa as she spoke with Action News.

Janet's 12-year-old daughter, Delisha, was one of 11 people killed in the bombing. She and others from the MOVE organization were imprisoned when the bombing happened. She was told that her child's remains had been turned over to relatives.

All this time, though, those remains have been at the University of Pennsylvania's Museum. Museum workers found them on Tuesday as they were conducting inventory. "The things we heard they did to our family's remains are horrifying," said Janet Africa. In 2021, the [University of Pennsylvania admitted to keeping the bones](#) of at least one victim. There was also a [box of remains discovered](#) at the city of Philadelphia's medical examiner's office. Remains of victims were also being used at Princeton University.

One by one they're being returned to the families who lost loved ones, including Janine Africa, whose son was one of five children killed in the bombing. "This is just an act of vengeance and hate," she said.

Penn Museum released a statement that said in part, "Confronting our institutional history requires ever-evolving examination of how we can uphold museum practices to the highest ethical standards."

The family says they don't want an apology or money. Instead, they're pushing for the release of Mumia Abu-Jamal, an activist and journalist who they say was wrongfully convicted of murder.

They say his release would bring them a sense of justice after all that's happened and the trust that has been broken. "They wouldn't even let our family rest in peace," said Janet Africa." Source: Email.

"A history of the "Virgin Island Five", a group of activists accused of murdering eight people in the U.S. Virgin Islands. The murders took place during a turbulent period of rebellion on the Islands. The island was put under virtual martial law, and eventually five men: Ismail Ali, Warren (Aziz) Ballantine, Meral (Malik) Smith, Raphael (Kwesi) Joseph,

and Hanif Shabazz Bey were apprehended and then charged with the attack. All the men were known

supporters of the Virgin Island independence movement. The five were charged after being subjected to vicious torture, in order to extract confessions. They were beaten, hung from their feet and necks from trees, subject to electric shocks with “cattle prods”, had plastic bags tied over their heads and had water forced up their noses by the “defenders of the law.” The judge (Warren Young) overlooking the case prior to being placed on the federal bench worked as Rockefeller’s private attorney and even handled legal matters for the Fountain Valley Golf Course. Eventually, the five went to trial in what became known as the “Fountain Valley” murder trial. This was an obvious Kangaroo Court and a mockery of any sense of a fair trial. On August 13, 1973, each of the five men convicted and sentenced to eight (8) consecutive life terms.

Today, Warren (Aziz) Ballantine, Meral (Malik) Smith, and Hanif Shabazz Bey are all confined in federal prisons. Ismail Ali was liberated to Cuba via an airplane hijacking in 1984. Raphael (Kwesi) Joseph was granted a pardon by the V.I. governor in 1992. Six years later Kwesi was mysteriously found dead of poison-laced drug overdose, after it was said that he was about to reveal evidence that would have exonerated at least one or more defendants.” <https://www.thejerichomovement.com/profile/malik-smith> <http://abcf.net/abc/pdfs/vi5.pdf>

“FMC CARSWELL is a federal medical centre in Fort Worth, Texas. This conjures up the kindly atmosphere of a hospital where a gentle orderly takes the patient’s temperature. Unfortunately, it is a prison.

I have been to many American prisons in the last 40 years, and they are all ghastly. Even the women's institutions tend to be overrun by gangs, with sexual violence the norm.

But some are worse than others. FMC Carswell is a high-security prison, and Aafia Siddiqui is slated to spend the rest of her life there — under US law, **she will be well over 100 years old before she is eligible for release.** Life expectancy in US prisons hovers around 60. FMC Carswell is not just a prison; it is a mile and a half onto a huge military base. On Jan 19, I had a legal visit with Aafia. It came after a week in Guantánamo Bay, so I was prepared for the fabulous inefficiency of the US military and I was not particularly surprised when it took them almost three hours to let me in. I was irked, though, as it cut the time I had with Aafia to 80 minutes. The tragedy of her story is well known. There is great doubt when it comes to the allegations against her — nobody says she hurt anyone, and much of the evidence was manifestly extorted out of her and other prisoners who had also been tortured. **The notion that she was a threat to the serried ranks of armed American personnel is risible.** However, there is little doubt about the violence that has been done to her: the US admits that she was shot when she was already in custody.

She has been repeatedly beaten, and she lost all her top front teeth when she was kicked in the face in one such incident. She is unique insofar as she seems to have been the only woman in the CIA Rendition-to-Torture programme.

In the end she was rendered from Bagram prison in Afghanistan to the US and sentenced to 86 years under lock and key. **She faces daily abuse in the US secret prison system, which she is meant to endure until about the year 2094.**

From time to time, there have been rumours that she had died. No doubt there are many officials in both the US and Pakistan who secretly wish this was true. This is at least one piece of 'fake news' I can put to rest. Physically, dental work aside, she struck me as in reasonable shape for a 50-year old who has been through so much. **But we can be fairly confident that she is not going to die anytime soon by natural causes.**

On the other hand, the mistreatment visited on her over many years was specifically designed to break her spirit. It is a stain on my country that we used sexual abuse, beatings, sleep deprivation and other torture. *Psychologically, Aafia is not doing well. None of the 87 male prisoners I have seen in Guantánamo have been traumatised to the same extent.*

She is now in an institution that ought to be helping to repair this damage. To the contrary, it exacerbates her nightmare.

In the end, this is a challenge for the Pakistan government. I am, of course, happy to be of assistance, and I ask nothing in return. I hope to visit Islamabad soon — to welcome some of my Pakistani Guantánamo clients home — and I hope to use this opportunity to meet with the responsible officials. Aafia's problem is that she is one totally powerless woman in prison run by Americans who — at best — care nothing for her.

To understand the Pakistan government's duty, one only has to read the inside of Aafia's passport: the "Ministry of Interior, Government of Pakistan, requires and requests in the name of the President, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, all those whom it may concern to allow the bearer to pass freely without let or hindrance and to afford the bearer such assistance and protection as may be necessary."

Aafia is being provided with little 'assistance' and no 'protection'. This has to change. Meanwhile, she cannot 'pass freely' to the toilet, let alone back to her home and family in Karachi. It is not rocket science to figure out the solution, and it represents a win-win proposition for both countries: President Biden would look strong if, for example, he swapped her for Dr Shakil Afridi. Even though I oppose assassination under all circumstances, we have to understand those who make decisions: The US media would portray this as winning liberty for the man who allegedly helped to assassinate Osama bin Laden. Meanwhile, Pakistan would have brought home a woman whose plight has come to represent the very worst excesses of the 'War on Terror'.

I think I could persuade the Americans to get this done. Who, then, in Pakistan is standing in the way of such a solution and why? Let's get past that and get it done.--Clive Smith <https://aafiamovement.com/>

Current & Former Political Prisoner (and Politicized) Voices

An update from Keith...

(Keith LaMar)

“In a few weeks I'll have reached the one-year anniversary of my reprieve, which I'm now pausing to acknowledge. It's been a momentous year full of high energy and a growing sense of urgency, both personally and collectively. We've just marked the one-year anniversary of the conflict in Palestine, where it's said that up to 100,000 people have perished (SMH). And now, in the throes of another election cycle, it feels as if the world itself is coming undone, bursting at the seams it seems. And I'm so tired!

It's 2:32 in the morning, and all is quiet here where I am. I can hear only the hiss of the air blowing through the vent, and that's it, which is rare around here. Most times there's a lot of kicking and screaming going on, a routine that will resume soon enough, no doubt. As surely as the sun follows the moon. This is my sweet spot, the rare few hours of undisturbed peace, and I set my alarm to purposefully put myself here, right here, in this moment. It's the only time I can hear myself think, hear myself breathe. . .

I feel like sharing: What an incredible year it's been! This time last year I was worried that maybe I wouldn't see December, and so much has happened since then. Good, bad, and beautiful.

THE GOOD

I have now in my arsenal a team of very capable attorneys who are working diligently to undo my wrongful conviction. And we're making progress! I've been touring with the Freedom First band, doing concerts all over the country and around the world, a blessing that I still find impossible to comprehend. How, how, how?! We've received awards, performed with an orchestra (Inner City Youth Orchestra of Los Angeles at UCLA), and have in every way exceeded all expectations of what might be possible from where I stand. It's glorious, man!

THE BAD

Since receiving the reprieve, a group of guards has taken it upon themselves to torture me. Ironically, the state of Ohio has exhausted its supply of the drugs needed to carry out lethal injections, but not a day goes by that my cell isn't sprayed with mace or some other kind of chemical meant to harm and/or distract me. I noticed it even before the reprieve, but it definitely picked up once it became clear I wouldn't be executed. I've complained, but the administration has all but told me that I'm on my own. I've even been referred to the psychiatrist (as in: you must be crazy if you think we give a damn!). This is the part of the so-called "justice system" that no one sees. And the same people who're putting poison in my food sit on juries and intend to turn out in droves to vote for Trump, as if. . .

A few weeks ago, a man by the name of Marcellus Williams was executed in Missouri, even after evidence of his innocence was presented, even in the face of widespread support from the victim's family and prosecuting attorney. Over and over we see examples of this corrupt system and how it operates. What astonishes is the "business-as-usual" bullshit that's used to justify yet another departure from what we claim to believe in.

THE BEAUTIFUL

I was the keynote speaker at a high school graduation a few months ago in New York City. I got to share with a group of young people my attitude of resiliency.

I've completed some awesome paintings that adorn the walls of my cell; they represent the countless hours I've stolen back from this monstrosity, the ways in which I've sublimated my pain and turned darkness into light.

I'm also happy to announce that my literacy project, Native Sons, awarded scholarships to another batch of first-year college students who're finding their way forward. We also were able to donate a library to the Juvenile Detention Center here in Youngstown, as part of my quest to bring literacy to youth who're at risk of being swallowed up by this rigged system. I'm so proud of these accomplishments!

Indeed, there are so many things that break my heart in this world, especially in this society, where hypocrisy is so rampant. But I refuse to believe that any of THAT should have the final say on what will become of us. In ways both big and small, I'm reminded that it's not really what's in front of us that matters, but who's beside us. It matters whose hand we hold and how we show up for each other. Like I told a group of students this summer: the momentum is in favor of darkness, but if and when we reach for the light we will be helped.

For centuries, for generations, people have had to struggle for freedom, for respect, for justice. Why should this time be any different?

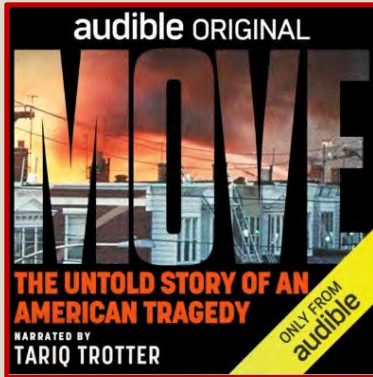

“Audible, the Amazon-owned podcast and audiobook service, has partnered with the multiplatform media company Macro and Cultivate Entertainment to release “[MOVE: The Untold Story of an American Tragedy](#).” The nine-episode audio drama investigates the Philadelphia-based Black liberation group MOVE and its clash with local law enforcement. Hosted by Tariq Trotter of The Roots, the podcast series debuts on Audible Aug. 8.

In the 1970s, a man known as John Africa founded a controversial Black separatist organization in Philadelphia called MOVE. Members lived in communes according to the lifestyle of Africa, which included free-thinking, a strict raw food diet and deep respect for all living things. As MOVE gained influence, it attracted the attention of Philadelphia law enforcement.

In 1978, a shootout between MOVE and the West Philadelphia Police resulted in the death of one officer and sent nine MOVE members to prison. On May 13, 1985, the City of Philadelphia bombed the MOVE headquarters, resulting in the death of six adults and five children.

“I am thrilled to be a part of this incredible project. ‘MOVE’ is more than just a historical dramatic series; it’s a powerful tribute to community and the relentless pursuit of justice,” Trotter said. “I believe this work will resonate deeply with audiences and contribute to the cultural conversation in a meaningful way.”

Showrunner and executive producer Kevin Arbouet lead the project with co-creator, head writer and producer Curtis Bryant. 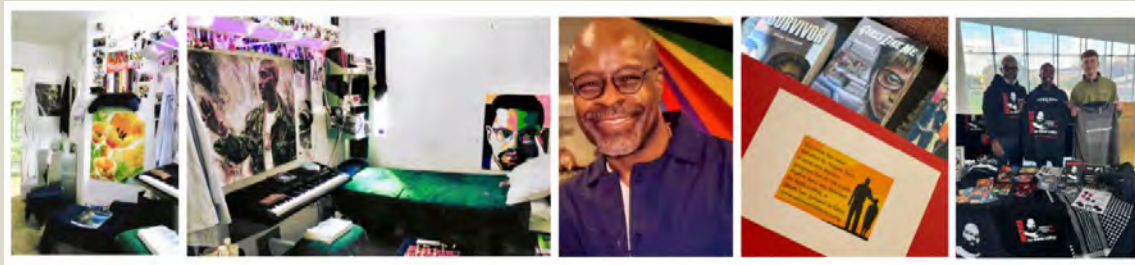

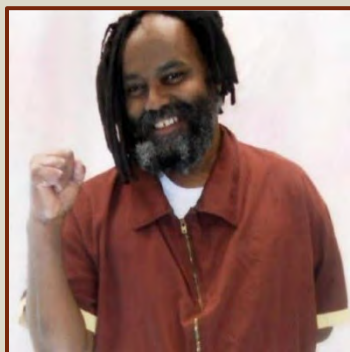

* In 1970 Black Panther Party (BPP) leader Huey Newton gave groundbreaking [public support to the then-strong movements for women’s and gay liberation](#), criticizing homophobia and calling for the BPP to build an alliance with both movements. At the time, Mumia was the 16-year-old Communications Minister of the Philadelphia Chapter of the BPP. A taste of what Mumia told me:

When you think about what Huey said...about gay folks and lesbian and queer folks, I must be honest with you, it was not well received by members of the party....But as usual, this was Huey at his finest.

* Mumia pays tribute to the women of the BPP, whom he describes as “the glory of the party, the hardest workers, the most disciplined members and leaders.” In particular, he cites the key roles of former political prisoners Afeni Shakur, who (although not an attorney) brilliantly self-represented in the Panther 21 conspiracy frameup case -- all were acquitted -- and Ericka Huggins, a BPP leader who beat yet another conspiracy frameup, and whose husband, BPP member John Huggins, along with Bunchy Carter, were murdered in an FBI-induced plot. (Ericka, an out-queer woman who continues her lifelong community activism, has been a periodic guest on Out-FM.)

* Mumia explains how his thinking has significantly evolved since 1991, when he responded to a letter from Queers United in Support of Political Prisoners (QUISP) about our then-upcoming lesbian/gay forum to support him, by writing, “As a MOVE person, we see Heterosexual Hookups as natural and inherently right,” while also thanking and encouraging us to hold the event (we did). This started a long-term dialogue with Mumia by LGBTQ activists nationwide that played a role in his later evolution.

* Mumia cites the leading role of the late Delbert Africa, a member of the MOVE 9 (a frameup murder case) and political prisoner for 42 years, in arguing for support of the lesbian and gay community.

-Mumia also mentions the public support for lesbian and gay liberation by yet another ex-political prisoner, former BPP and Black Liberation Army member Dhoruba Bin Wahad. (We’ll play a short clip from Dhoruba’s powerful 1991 speech at the above-mentioned QUISP event.)

-Mumia speaks movingly about his first-hand knowledge of the “hell within a hell” suffered by gay and trans incarcerated men, mistreated by both staff and other prisoners. He mentions having witnessed attempted suicides.

Other components of the two-hour special:

-A short clip from the film **"Manufacturing Guilt: - A Short Film About Mumia Abu-Jamal's Case,"** by First Run Features.

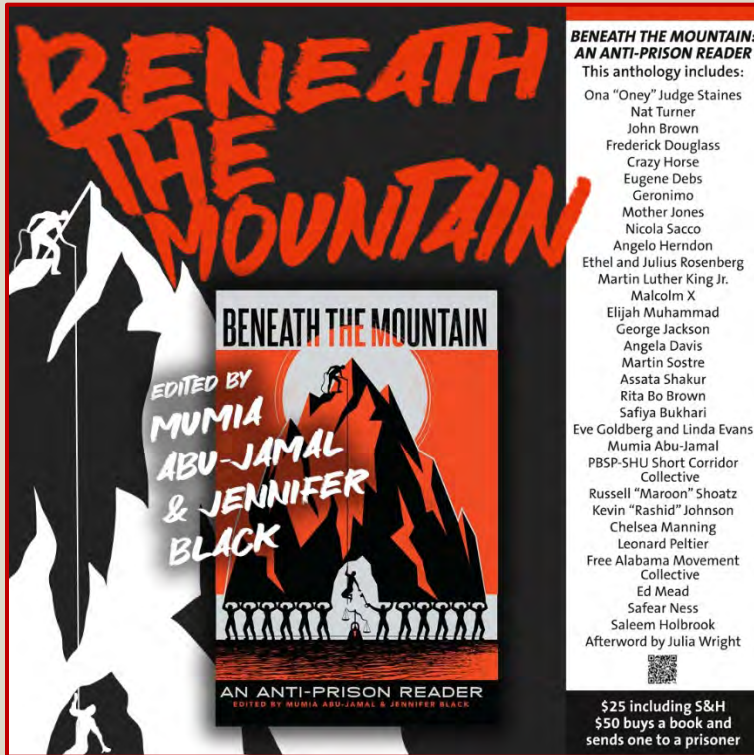
-Two of Mumia’s audio commentaries, from 2000 and 2019, decrying the murders of white gay men and Black trans women, respectively, and putting both in the context of a violent, racist society.

-A brief excerpt of a recent phone dialogue between Mumia and students who had organized various Palestine/Gaza solidarity encampments, where he answers questions about strategy and tactics to build a strong movement.

-What’s happening now with Mumia’s legal case and the importance of movement organizing to free him and other political prisoners.

Association of Democratic Lawyers — concludes its investigation of Israel’s systematic violations of international law with a clear, concrete, and urgent call to governments across the globe: now is the time for a total energy, economic and arms embargo against Israel. Dear Friend and Fellow Freedom Fighter,

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict [HERE](#)), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, right-wing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
