

"We are deeply saddened by the loss of Black Panther Veteran Katherine Campbell. Many in San Francisco and Oakland knew her for holding a Free Breakfast Program every year in October to teach the community about the Panthers' survival programs, the last of which she just held at the @blackpantherpartymuseum, alongside her comrades and community. She was dedicated to preserving and promoting the legacy of the Black Panther Party, serving on the Museum's advisory board, giving tours at the Museum, and working with the Black Panther Party Alumni Legacy Network. Her desire for liberation stemmed from her upbringing in the Fillmore, her work developing pictures and doing the layout for the Black Panther Party Newspaper, and her service to the community through the Sickle Cell Anemia Program, Seniors Against a Fearful Environment, Oakland Community School, and the Free Breakfast Program. Serving in the Party from 1969 - 1978, Katherine was a giant in our community and a Panther through and through. She will be remembered for her dedication, her kind spirit, and for always leading with love. She served her people, body and soul, up to the very last days of her life. A Call for Mass Struggle Against U.S.-Led War on Venezuela and the Caribbean

"Nov 14, 2025 — The U.S. empire, unable to accept the sovereignty, progress, and moral example of the Bolivarian Revolution, is escalating its aggressive attacks against Venezuela. This is by no means an isolated struggle — what started as aggression against Venezuela and the Bolivarian Revolution has already claimed several dozen lives of working-class people in the Caribbean and Pacific, extended to threats against Colombia and its President, been linked to the militarization of Ecuador and Panama, and re-militarized Puerto Rico. This is yet another front in the struggle against U.S. imperialism, and it is interlocked with our movements for liberation in Haiti, Palestine, throughout Our Americas, across the Global South, and within the borders of the United States.

It is the wider ongoing pattern of regional militarization and imperialist control that fundamentally violates the principles of a Zone of Peace, as the U.S. Southern Command (SOUTHCOM) has systematically transformed the Caribbean into a staging ground for its hegemonic projects. Puerto Rico, a colonial territory, is consistently used as a strategic site for the deployment and launch of military exercises, normalizing its status as a forward operating base, while nations like Guyana and Trinidad & Tobago are treated as subordinate "puppet states" that risk their own sovereignty to facilitate U.S. objectives. Simultaneously, Haiti has been cast as a laboratory for imperial policy, where an accelerated militarization and occupation over the last four years has provided a blueprint for intervention. The racist and cynical designation of Haitian paramilitary armed groups as "terrorists" to be eradicated by US-led occupation has done nothing to relieve impoverished, marginalized Haitians from the violence of these "gangs" — because they are a direct consequence of imperialism. And yet, the excuse and label of "terrorism" has now been directly exported to the case of Venezuela. There, the U.S. Department of War cynically compares Caribbean people in fishing boats to Al-Qaeda, a transparent tactic to manufacture a pretext for full military invasion and attack..." Announcing the publication of *For the baby ancestors in Gaza* a volume of poetry by Julia Wright



"Detroit, MI: Fighting-Words and its publishing team are proud to present a volume of poetry by Julia Wright titled For the baby ancestors in Gaza and other poems. Ms. Wright writes in her Introduction "Then came October 7th and the genocidal months over two years of writing near daily poems for Palestine, as if I was keeping a journal and as if the least I could do was to give CPR at a distance." Julia Wright is the elder daughter of the late African American novelist, journalist and poet, Richard Wright. She is a descendant of the survivors of the 1919 Elaine Massacre through her lynched great uncle, Silas Hoskins. A Pan Africanist, she served under Kwame Nkrumah until the CIA-abetted coup d'etat in Ghana in 1966. She subsequently worked with James Forman in SNCC and went on to attend the first cultural Pan African Festival in Algiers alongside Kathleen and Eldridge Cleaver of the Black Panther Party. In Paris, France, she cofounded, in 1995, Wednesday rallies for political prisoners Mumia Abu-Jamal and Leonard Peltier, that are still ongoing.

The Foreword to Ms. Wright's book of poems is by Yousef M. Aljamal, editor of *If I Must Die* and executor of the papers of Refaat Alareer, poet and teacher targeted and murdered in Gaza by the Israeli Occupation Forces.

as a fellow poet


deserving your grief and anger


as a stranger who meant you no harm

"One of the most revered voices in Black American Islam, Imam Al-Hajj Talib Abdur-Rashid of The Mosque of Islamic Brotherhood, has passed away, leaving Harlem and the broader Muslim community in profound grief. His death marks the end of nearly five decades of leadership, scholarship, and activism rooted deeply in the tradition of Malcolm X and the Black liberation legacy of Harlem.

Imam Talib served as leader of the Mosque of Islamic Brotherhood since 1988, succeeding the late Shaykh El-Hajj K. Ahmad Tawfiq al-Azhari, under whom he trained as assistant imam. His spiritual lineage traces directly back to El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz, making him, as community leaders describe, "a living chain" to one of America's most influential Muslim figures. His impact was felt far beyond the walls of the mosque, reaching deep into the civic, cultural, and political life of New York City.

This past week, Imam Talib delivered the closing prayer at the Urban League Empowerment Center grand opening in Harlem. Today, the organization expressed sorrow over his passing, saying they were "deeply grateful" for the wisdom he shared and would hold his words "even closer" as they mourn alongside his family and community.

Community tributes have been pouring in since the announcement of his death. Global Islamic historian Shaykh Abdullah Hakim Quick described him as "a courageous Imam, a deep thinker, a beloved father, and a dedicated community activist." He prayed that Allah accept Imam Talib's sacrifice and reunite him with the Prophet at the Hawd, the sacred fountain on the Day of Judgment.

Muslim Media Corporation founder Sheikh Musa Drammeh echoed that sentiment, calling him "one of the greatest Muslim leaders of our time," a man who propagated Islam not just with words but with character and compassion. "May Allah grant him Jannat al-Firdaws," he said.

Mayor-Elect Zohran Mamdani sent this message through X, "Saddened to learn about the passing of Imam Talib Abdur-Rashid, a pillar of the African-American Muslim community in Harlem and for Muslims across NYC. My heartfelt condolences go out to his family and the community during this difficult time. Inna lillahi wa inna ilaihi raji'un." Adama Bah, immigrant rights activist and founder of Afrikana, spoke emotionally about the weight of losing an elder who fought tirelessly for future generations. "You can't talk about Harlem without mentioning his name, and you can't talk about Black Muslims without honoring his legacy," she said. "The legacy they leave behind lives on through the people they struggled for."

Muhammadd Anwaarul-Haq, an Islamic scholar, emphasized Imam Talib's role as a direct intellectual and spiritual descendant of the Malcolm X tradition. "He served the NYC community for almost 50 years," he said, noting Imam Talib's mentorship under Shaykh Tawfiq, who himself studied under El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz. "That means he is our direct sanad—our spiritual chain—to Malcolm X. Along with being an impeccable scholar dedicated to knowledge, worship, and piety, he was a dynamic community leader who understood that spirituality and service must go hand in hand."

Anwaarul-Haq also revealed the Imam's behind-the-scenes influence in civic life, noting that Imam Talib played a significant role in helping Mayor-elect Zohran Mamdani build community trust during his rise to political leadership. "His advice, experience, and community networks were priceless. He was active until yesterday, still posting community updates."

Imam Talib's passing leaves a void in Harlem and across New York that many fear cannot easily be filled. For decades, he stood at the intersection of faith, justice, and community, mentoring youth, advocating for the poor, challenging oppression, and protecting the legacy of Black Muslim history. His mosque became a beacon not just for worship, but for organizing, healing, and empowerment.

As Harlem mourns, the call to honor his legacy grows louder: to continue the work he dedicated his life to—uplifting the marginalized, pursuing justice, and embodying the compassion and dignity he preached.

Funeral arrangements will be announced by the Mosque of Islamic Brotherhood.



From UAINE: Leonard Peltier also has sent us a WRITTEN STATEMENT in addition to the video that we all saw at National Day of Mourning 2025. Here's what he wrote: LEONARD PELTIER - DAY OF MOURNING 2025 ©" "Every day has been a Day of Mourning for a few centuries now. Every day has also been a victory. Every one of us is a battle that has been won.

Our ancestors have survived the slaughter of those who sought to end us. The Trail of Tears. The Wounded Knee Massacre. The endless brutal attacks. The corrupt Washington policy meant to erase us.

They want to erase that history, you know. They are giving medals back to Cavalrymen who slaughtered over 250 people. They want to sugar-coat that memory. That's not going to happen – the truth is the truth. We should not have to insist that we have not vanished. We will be seen. We will be heard. Our children will grow and thrive. Our history, unlike that of the colonizers, is real. It is passed down and rooted in the earth. Their history changes with every new book they write.

We have won battles, but make no mistake, the war rages on. Now more than ever, we must stand up for our treaty rights. If we lose those, we cease to exist as a people.

We are the First People. Mother Earth herself forges our bodies and ignites our blood. Perhaps they realize our spirits are one. Maybe they understand that we belong to the forces of nature – they can't dominate the wind. Maybe they harbor a jealousy they don't understand. We are a people with riches they will never know. I made it home, home to my people.

The drums I heard outside the British Columbia jail have sustained me through 49 years of waking up in a coffin every morning.

You cried, "Don't let them kill you!"

I did not let them kill me.

It has been close—I've seen death approaching more than once.

I want to extend my heart to the supporters who fought for my freedom. You gave me my mass public outcry. It consisted of a pressure that persisted and intensified for five decades.

We must unite — red, yellow, black, and white. If we don't stand together, we will face defeat before we even begin. Raise your voice, not your fist. Violence will land you in your own prison cell.

Let's prove that we can change the world without declaring war on it.

Reservations, meant to be sovereign nations, are all too often concentration camps. We live in dangerous times. Our people have been targeted for hundreds of years. Others are finding out that civil rights are nothing but words. Dangerous words, when you believe they protect you.

Mother Earth is in trouble – she has been stripped of almost all that sustains life.

We have made progress. There are Indigenous-owned businesses. Kids from reservations are earning degrees, although they have nowhere to live when they return. I am home. I have an awesome new cell, but it is still a prison cell. I must get approval for every move I make.

As I said, the war rages on. My personal freedom, once more, reflects our freedom as a People. We must unite with one another and our allies to face the storm we know is coming.

We must face what lies ahead with our heads held high and our spirits intact. We have faced their atrocities for hundreds of years, and we remain undestroyed. We draw our strength, our very breath, from the Great Spirit. They have their billionaires. There is no fortitude in a dollar bill.







"Oso Blanco became known by the authorities as "Robin the Hood" after the FBI and local gang unit APD officers learned from a CI that he was robbing banks to send thousands of dollars to the Zapatista Rebels of Chiapas regularly during 1998 and 1999.

He is now serving 55 years in prison for bank robbery, aggravated assault on the FBI, escape and firearms charges. Oso Blanco defended himself from federal agents in a gun battle on August 13th 1999 at his home in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Although he escaped, he was arrested later that day and sentenced to time in New Mexico's state Penitentiary. After serving just over a year in New Mexico, he escaped from a prison transport van and almost immediately began robbing banks. He was recaptured a short time later. Oso Blanco never used a gun in any bank robbery, but he has a long history of living by the gun and will not hesitate to use it on the agents of repression or the occupiers of Aztlán who force false laws on the true people of this land. He is not asking for monetary support; he's only asking that people become aware of indigenous people's issues. In an interview he expressed "I am still able to hold my head up high and feel the gratification for my work in a world where money, power and destructive industries are regarded far above humanity, indigenous

"We shall no longer kill Mother Earth and everything else just to have modern technologies and pay for death as tax slaves. We shall rise up refusing to be slaves to commerce and political lies, in our own Land." "We shall be High master" – High master of the heart Realm of Higher Consciousness.

- **3.** Jeff Fort: 78-Year-Old Political Prisoner Hospitalized After Collapsing at ADX Florence Supermax Prison--"Jeff Fort, a 78-year-old federal prisoner who has spent 19 years in extreme solitary confinement at ADX Florence—the federal Bureau of Prisons' most restrictive facility—was recently hospitalized following a sudden medical emergency that left him unconscious in his cell with a head injury.

Around October 19, 2025, Mr. Fort experienced an abrupt blackout with no warning signs, falling from a standing position and striking his head on the concrete floor of his cell. Correctional officers found him unconscious and disoriented. He was rushed by ambulance, where he underwent extensive emergency diagnostic testing, including CT scans, blood work, and cardiograms at a local hospital. This incident has raised grave concerns about his deteriorating health and the risks posed by his continued confinement under extreme isolation at ADMAX." "Mr. Fort experiences ongoing difficulty breathing during the day and shortness of breath at night. He has a documented history of blackout episodes dating back to 2006-2007, typically with warning signs that allowed him to protect himself—but this recent incident provided no such opportunity. He also struggles with CPAP therapy and has experienced significant weight loss—dropping to approximately 180-185 pounds, which is likely linked to dental issues and delays in receiving dentures that make eating difficult." "Mr. Fort's legal team, led by attorney Jenipher R. Jones, with independent medical advisor Dr. Barbara Zeller, is actively pursuing multiple avenues for relief. "The combination of advanced age, serious medical issues including fainting spells and breathing difficulties, significant weight loss, and 19 years of extreme isolation creates an unconscionable situation," stated Jenipher R. Jones, Esq., Mr. Fort's attorney with For the People, LLC. "Keeping a nearly 80-year-old man under these conditions is medically dangerous. We look forward to working with the Bureau of Prisons to improve this situation. - Support Mr. Fort's request for immediate medical transfer to an appropriate facility

Urgent Call to Action for Political Prisoner Rev. Joy Powell

"Greetings Everyone, I just had a disturbing call from Rev. Joy Powell, about incidents which occurred over the course of the last two days that may or may not have been intentionally perpetrated by state employees, but nonetheless have resulted in injuries to Rev. Joy's hand, her arm, and other parts of her body, for which she also explained her concerns about her wrist which had already been fractured on multiple occasions before, and yet she is being denied medical attention she was promised by staff officer's on duty she would get and hasn't. A member of the National Guard is the person responsible for multiple injuries, which happened in two separate incidents but involved facility movement where a gate and door were closed without warning before Rev. Joy had safely cleared from the entrance in question. The person's last name responsible is Johnson, he is a part of military reservist unit assigned to that facility.

Bedford Hills permanent facility staff involved names are Rios, and Lopez, both of them have lied to Rev. Joy about transporting her to medical for x-rays and any other medical treatment needed. One of the Women Beater Brigade, Officer Shakel, has told Rev. Joy during previous incidents that a broken wrist or arm is not considered a medical emergency by Bedford Hills.

There were witnesses to these events; they too were harassed and chastised by staff officer Ortiz just for questioning staff and inquiring about Rev. Joy's well-being and imploring staff to provide her with needed medical attention.

They've locked Rev. Joy up in her cell and sought to ignore her at this point. She needs everyone to please make the following phone calls asap, since we're late into the day on a Friday following a holiday, and please vociferously demand that Rev. Joy receive immediate medical attention for her injuries suffered, and that these incidents which possibly involve acts of targeting by the National Guard member and other facility staff be fully investigated.

Letter Writing Script

Dear [Recipient's Name or Title],

I am writing to urgently demand immediate medical attention for Rev. Joy Powell (#07g0632), currently incarcerated at Bedford Hills Correctional Facility. Over the past two days, Rev. Powell has suffered multiple injuries, including to her wrist and arm, after incidents involving a National Guard reservist identified as Johnson. Despite promises from staff, she has been denied medical treatment, including radiology services and evaluation for her injuries.

Facility staff members Rios and Lopez misled her about medical transport, while Officer Shakel stated that a broken wrist or arm is "not considered a medical emergency." Witnesses to these events were harassed by Officer Ortiz simply for advocating for Rev. Powell's well-being. Rev. Powell has now been locked in her cell and ignored, despite her urgent medical needs.

I demand the following actions without delay:

- 1. Rev. Joy Powell must receive immediate medical care, including radiology services and treatment for her injuries.
- 2. A full investigation into the conduct of National Guard member Johnson and staff Rios, Lopez, Shakel, Ortiz.
- 3. Accountability measures to ensure staff do not retaliate against witnesses or deny medical care in the future. This situation is a matter of health, safety, and human rights. Please act swiftly to ensure Rev. Powell's well-being and to uphold the standards of care and accountability expected of your office.

History & Background

750 Nostrand Avenue, located in the heart of #BlackBrooklyn has been the longtime home of the beloved The Black Lady Theatre, owned and operated by the African-American father-son duo, Clarence Jr. 2X Hardy
Shabazz & Chief Minister Omar Hardy since 1999. In January 2018, The Hardys discovered that the three-story building at 750 Nostrand Ave had been reportedly sold in a tax-lien foreclosure auction — an action for which the Hardys were never notified or properly served. What has unfolded since is not an isolated incident, but the continuation of a longstanding political and racial attack that began years earlier.

The theatre's founding member, Judge John L. Phillips Jr. faced political retaliation after deciding to run for office against then-District Attorney Charles "Joe" Hynes. The subsequent theft of this property represents the fallout of years of systemic targeting and planning, weaponizing legal and political power to dismantle a Black institution and seize its cultural and economic value. Today, Chief Minister Omar Hardy is still engulfed in a raging legal battle for the property's return. Meanwhile, notorious landlord of The OutPost Club and predatory developer, Mendel Gold has since been indicted for fraud and submitting falsified documents in another case.

Call for donations - medical crisis for Stop Cop City defendant



"Our comrade and **#stopcopcity** defendant @grimwomyn is dealing with a serious dental emergency. A dangerous infection has spread in one of her teeth, and she urgently needs a root canal. She doesn't have dental insurance, and despite months of trying, hasn't been able to secure a job that provides benefits or pays enough to cover major medical care.

Although the judge in the Stop Cop City case has indicated the RICO charge will be dropped, the written decision has not yet been submitted and the domestic terrorism charge is still active. These unresolved charges continue to block her from being hired in jobs that offer insurance or a living wage, leaving her without access to basic healthcare.

She's trying to raise \$3,000 this week to get the procedure before the infection spreads further. Without treatment, she risks losing more teeth—and untreated dental infections can lead to life-threatening complications, including heart issues. The only alternative is a full extraction, which could destabilize the rest of her teeth and require additional costly procedures. If you can help or share, it means everything."

The Spirit of Mandela Coalition, following up on the October 2021 International Tribunal verdict finding the US Guilty of Genocide against Black, Brown, and Indigenous people (see full verdict HERE), is calling for the building of a new mass grassroots formation: The Peoples' Senate. The people need to govern and represent themselves in combating genocide and addressing their right to a just and humane existence. Our vision is for the Peoples' Senate, organized directly by our oppressed communities, to grow into a body which will serve that purpose.

Today our communities face the most egregious violations of our human rights since the civil rights and Black power movements of the 1960s and '70s. Conditions we are living under include random mass shootings, rightwing vigilante attacks, police violence and murder, environmental racism, the reassertion of "states rights" (the "right" of states to ignore basic human rights), and healthcare racism. The US government dangerously scapegoats immigrants; causes destabilization, extreme violence, bombing, and killing of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people all over the globe – and spends billions of dollars to do it; and keeps hundreds of thousands of people living in homelessness and poverty in the US. Our communities are facing targeted attacks against voting rights, workers' rights, women's rights, and Indigenous Peoples' rights as right-wing elected officials and appointed judges roll back decades of hard-won battles for justice. While out-voting right-wing candidates during elections is important, voting alone will not be enough. We must organize to put more pressure on the system for major change.

The US Congress and Senate are representatives of the rich and powerful. They refuse to address the necessity for universal healthcare or a sound nationwide infrastructure providing access to clean water and other necessities. Corporations ignore and violate the needs of the planet while evading their fair share of taxes. US prisons are filled with Black, Brown, Indigenous, and poor people, many incarcerated for crimes they did not commit and/or serving sentences that far outweigh whatever criminal acts they may have committed. The oppressed national communities of Black, Brown, and Indigenous peoples all have political prisoners and prisoners of war incarcerated since the 1960s until today, who have fought for our liberation and are being held in prison unjustly or only released when near death. We want them all freed now!

Building our own Peoples' Senate will enable us to organize locally from a position of strength and connect local activists with others, in other parts of the country, who may be pursuing similar goals while electing "Senators" who are mandated to represent our interests and demands. A Peoples' Senate can fight for changes that protect and ensure our right to vote, our right to control our own bodies, our right to live free from discrimination as LGBTQ+ people, our rights to living wages and safe working conditions, our rights to sovereignty and dignity, and our rights to live free from state violence and abuse.
